## U/S EXAMINATION OF ABDOMEN AND PELVIS :-

- Liver :- Normal in size and echotexture. No focal Lesion seen. Intra hepatic biliary radicals are not dilated. CBD and portal vein appears normal.
- Gallbladder :- Well distended, wall thickness appears normal. A polyp measuring 4mm is noted within the gall bladder.
- Spleen :- Normal in size and echo texture. No focal lesion seen.
- Pancreas :- Normal in size, contour and echo texture. No focal lesion seen. Pancreatic duct appears normal.
- Right Kidney :- Normal in size, shape, position and echotexture. Two calculi measuring 10mm and 7mm are noted in upper ureter, 4.0 cm distal to pelvi ureteric junction causing mild hydroureteronephrosis. Two renal calculi are noted, one in the upper calyx measuring 4mm and one in the lower calyx measuring 4mm.
- Left Kidney :- Normal in size, shape, position and echotexture. No calculus seen. No hydronephrosis noted.
- Bladder :- Well distended, wall thickness appears normal.
- Prostate :- Normal in size and echo texture.
- Retro peritoneum :- Aorta and IVC appears normal.
- No free fluid seen.
